**Blessed be the Holy Name of Mary!**

I hope you are doing well. I have been away for most of the last few weeks after Christmas. During that time, I have been praying for you all. It is good to be back! Permit to share some thoughts and reflection for the days that are coming up this week.

Tuesday is the feast day of St. Agnes, Virgin and Martyr. She is the patron of our diocese. It would be fitting to say a prayer at the Cathedral of St. Agnes for our Diocese. As you know the Cathedral is close by. It's about a 10-minute drive across Sunrise Highway.

Wednesday is the Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. I was quite surprised to hear that some employers give employees a sick leave for their pets but there is no legal right to life for unborn human beings. Such are the times that we are living in. Let us pray for a legal end to abortion and for the legal protection of the intrinsic right to life. It would be appropriate to consider fasting or some other type of penance on this day as an offering of reparation to Christ.

Friday is the Memorial of St. Francis De Sales. His spiritual classic, *The Introduction of the Devout Life*, is a must read for any Catholic, most especially the laity. In fact, it was written for the laity. It is organized very well and it shows how one can integrate every aspect of one's daily life to Jesus. Please read it!

Saturday is the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul. If I am not mistaken, this feast day is the only feast day of the Universal Church that has to do with a saint's conversion. Yet, what a conversion it was! From being an anti-Christian in the worst way, to be called by Christ as an apostle, and baptizing more Christians than any other, and dying as a martyr! Wow! What a testament of the power of God's grace. This feast day is essentially what the Christian life is about. To turn away from one's sins (self) and to live in complete loving dependence in Christ. That is what St. Paul did.

Lastly, the greatest day of the week is Sunday, the Lord's Day. On this day is the Third Sunday of Ordinary Time. And the Gospel is from the Gospel of Luke: Jesus reading from the scroll of Isaiah at Nazareth. Some of the Church fathers claim that Isaiah must have encountered a certain divine manifestation of Jesus Christ within his life in order to be able to write so prophetically about Him. Have a blessed week. God bless you.

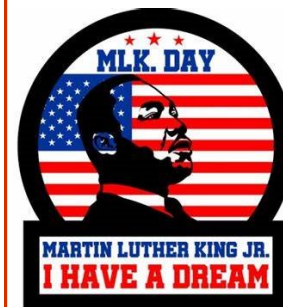
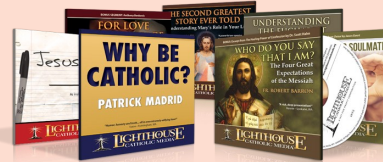

Join the Diocese of RVC for a historic occasion as we celebrate our Eucharistic Congress on Pentecost Sunday, 2025, at St. Anthony's High School. Prepare your hearts by learning about the Eucharist, encountering Christ in Adoration, and joining in our Eucharistic Pilgrimages from May 31-June 8.



Beginning on May 31, 2025, the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, two nine-day Eucharistic Pilgrimages will embark across Long Island, both culminating at St. Anthony's High School on Sunday, June 8, 2025, for the celebration of our local Diocesan Eucharistic Congress. The Western Route will journey from St. Agnes Cathedral (Rockville Centre) through Nassau County, while the Eastern Route will journey from the Parish of St. Therese of Lisieux (Montauk) through Suffolk County.

The Holy Eucharist will be carried in procession across the Diocese through many of our towns, schools, hospitals, cemeteries and parishes. During this pilgrimage, there will be opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration, the celebration of Mass, Eucharistic Catechesis, Praise and Worship, public processions, and other Eucharistic celebrations. The People of God will be invited to walk with Jesus, truly present in the Holy Eucharist, pray in the pilgrim churches and proclaim the Gospel to bystanders as Jesus passes through their towns.

**PERPETUAL PILGRIMS.** The diocese is inviting a dedicated group of young adults, (18-29), to apply to be *Perpetual Pilgrims*. These Perpetual Pilgrims will make the entire 9 day journey with the Lord in the Eucharist across the Diocese from May 31-June 7, along with priest chaplains and an official pilgrimage team. These pilgrims will represent the many young people from across LI who are on fire with Eucharistic love and missionary fervor. Applicants should be in good physical condition, capable of walking long distances, and committed to Christ, the teachings of His Church, and ongoing intellectual and spiritual formation.

¡Bendito sea el Santo Nombre de María!

Espero que se encuentren bien. He estado ausente durante la mayor parte de las últimas semanas después de Navidad. Durante ese tiempo, he estado rezando por todos ustedes. ¡Es bueno estar de vuelta! Permítanme compartir algunos pensamientos y reflexiones para los días que se avecinan esta semana.

El martes es el día de la festividad de Santa Inés, Virgen y Mártir. Ella es la patrona de nuestra diócesis. Sería apropiado decir una oración en la Catedral de Santa Inés por nuestra diócesis. Como saben, la Catedral está cerca. Se encuentra a unos 10 minutos en auto cruzando Sunrise Highway.

El miércoles es el Día de Oración por la Protección Legal de los Niños No Nacidos. Me sorprendió bastante escuchar que algunos empleadores les dan a los empleados una licencia por enfermedad para sus mascotas, pero no existe un derecho legal a la vida para los seres humanos no nacidos. Así son los tiempos en los que vivimos. Oremos por el fin legal del aborto y por la protección legal del derecho intrínseco a la vida. Sería apropiado considerar el ayuno o algún otro tipo de penitencia en este día como una ofrenda de reparación a Cristo.

El viernes es la memoria de San Francisco de Sales. Su clásico espiritual, *Introducción a la vida devota*, es una lectura obligada para cualquier católico, especialmente para los laicos. De hecho, fue escrito para los laicos. Está muy bien organizado y muestra cómo uno puede integrar cada aspecto de su vida diaria a Jesús. ¡Por favor, léalo!

El sábado es la fiesta de la Conversión de San Pablo. Si no me equivoco, este día festivo es el único día festivo de la Iglesia Universal que tiene que ver con la conversión de un santo. Sin embargo, ¡qué conversión fue! De ser un anticristiano en el peor sentido, a ser llamado por Cristo como apóstol, y bautizar a más cristianos que cualquier otro, y morir como mártir. ¡Guau!
