Gospel: Luke 3:15-16, 21-22 The people wonder with great expectation if John might be the Christ.

FOCUS: In His birth (Christmas), His adoration by the Magi (Epiphany), and the coming of the Spirit upon Him (Baptism), Jesus is revealed to be the Son of God.

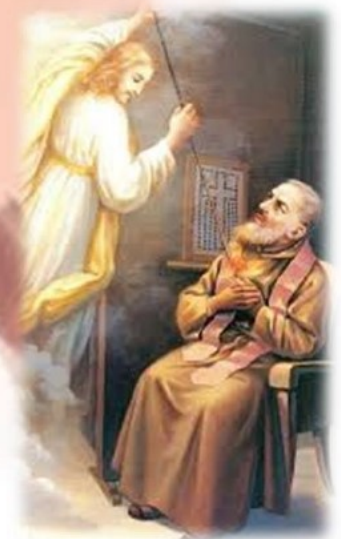
