Readings for 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time

1st Reading: Isaiah 6:1-2a, 3-8 Isaiah fearfully receives a heavenly vision and volunteers to be sent by the Lord.

2nd Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:1-11 or 15:3-8, 11 Paul, though unworthy, has embraced the call to be an apostle.

Gospel: Luke 5:1-11 Peter, a sinful man, and his partners accept a new commission from Jesus.

FOCUS: In the sight of the angels I will sing your praises, Lord. Both Isaiah and Simon Peter stand in awe of the power of the Lord. Isaiah declares his lips unclean and Peter calls himself a sinful man. They recognize their own lowliness in the face of the Lord's majesty. Paul reminds us that Christ died for our sins and was raised.

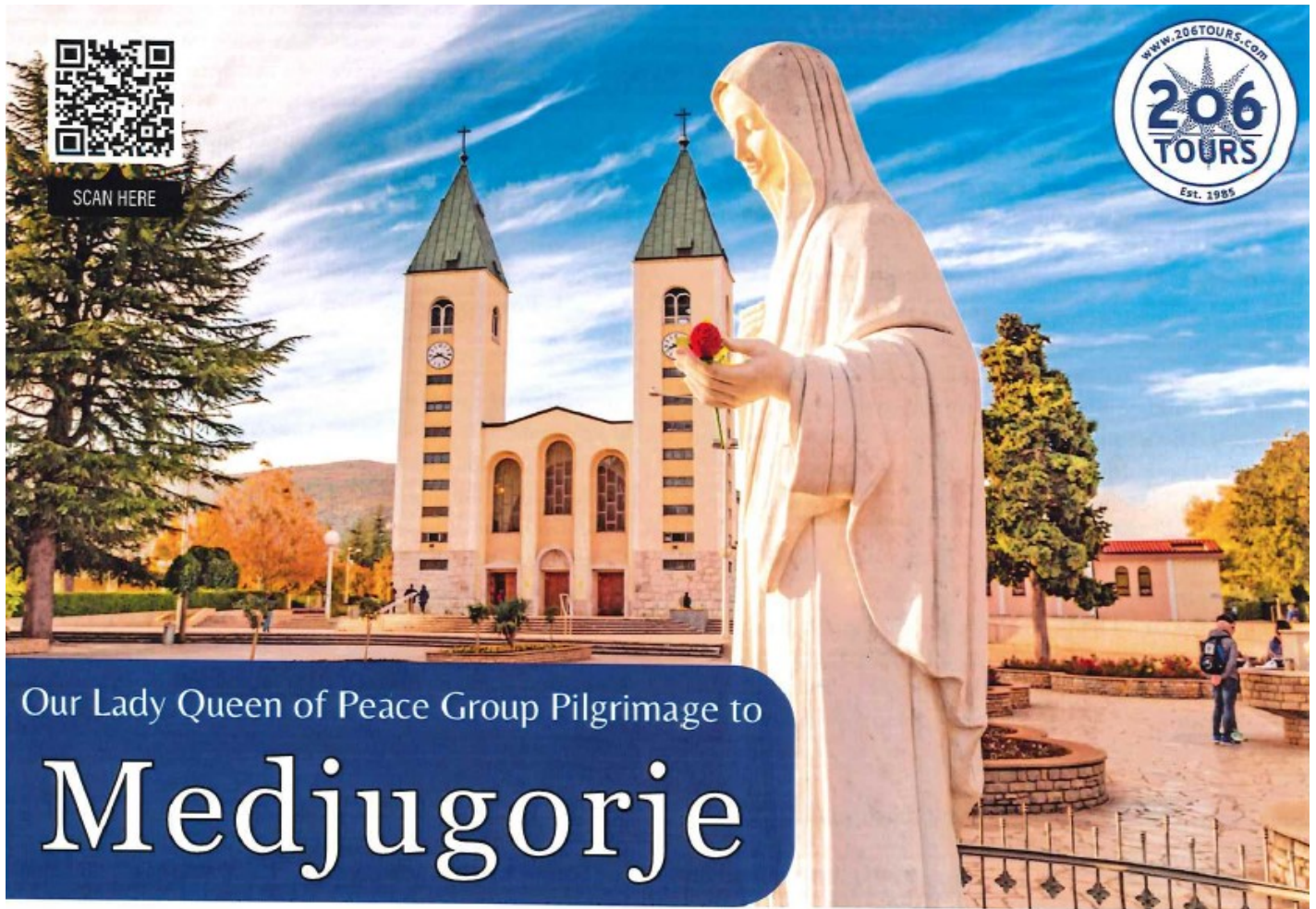
