Next Sunday's Liturgy—March 9

Readings for First Sunday of Lent

1st Reading: Deuteronomy 26:4-10 The first-fruits of the soil are offered to God who brought us to this place of abundance.

2nd Reading: Romans 10:8-13 Our profession of faith must be externally expressed and internally directing.

Gospel: Luke 4:1-13 Jesus experiences most profoundly the power of hunger and the greater power of God.

FOCUS: Engaging in challenges on our Lenten journey can help us prepare to carry our own cross.

One way Jesus prepared for his public ministry was to go into the desert, filled with the Holy Spirit, to be tempted by the devil. We may have to confront a similar experience during Lent. Jesus' example shows us the disposition we must have if we are to triumph over the enemy.

(Letter from February 16, 2025)

Blessed be the Holy Name of Mary!

We are all blest to be a part of Holy Name of Mary Parish. The love of Jesus Christ is truly present in us. I have been edified by the generous spirit that is greatly visible in our community. The parish means so much to so many of us. It is important that you as parishioners of Holy Name of Mary Church are informed of the financial status of our parish.

The financial summary of the fiscal year of September 1, 2023 - August 31, 2024 is attached to this week's bulletin. For the fiscal year of 2024, the parish had a deficit of \$203,393.92. Unfortunately, the parish has had a deficit in the last several years.

Over the years, expenses have increased along with a gradual decrease of income. This gradual decline of income comes from a decrease of Sunday collections (decrease of Mass attendance) along with a decline of weddings and funerals, etc.

Aside from this financial summary, late last year the parish paid \$29,572 for our portion of the diocesan bankruptcy settlement. As of August 31, 2024, the parish has 477,186.51 in reserves.

Certainly, these numbers are of great concern to you as it is to me. To help ease our financial expense, the parish has downsized in the last several months. The rectory is now closed from Friday to Sunday. Parish Outreach is no longer open on Fridays.

I know this is difficult news to hear. Yet, we are a people of hope. The parish staff and I are working on plans to revive the parish and parish school. We have every intention to revitalize the parish and school in its physical structure, financial wellbeing, and spiritual fruit.

As a parish we have a great staff, numerous faithful involved in parish ministries and generous loving parishioners. I am blest to serve and minister to you. Thank you for your love for Holy Name of Mary Parish. Let us continue to pray and do all that we can to promote the future and wellbeing of our parish church. God bless you.
