2nd Reading: Philippians 3:8-14 Nothing can be valued above the prize of our vocation in Christ Jesus.
Gospel: John 8:1-11 Accusing those around us gets a little harder after Jesus refuses to condemn an adulteress.
FOCUS: Christ looks at us as He looks at the woman caught in adultery, offering the forgiveness of our sins. Even if we are brought to shame before those of this world, we can have confidence in the mercy of Jesus, who will not condemn us. We have a new life with Christ, we have "been taken possession of by Christ Jesus," who says to us, "Go and from now on do not sin anymore."

Blessed be the Holy Name of Mary!

Laetare Sunday has arrived! This Sunday always falls on the 4th Sunday of Lent. It means to rejoice. Although it is a time of penance and conversion, Lent is a time of great hope.

To hope is to yearn for something that is not yet reached. It can be for someone in extreme distress or someone who has everything going for them. Putting it simply, as Christians our hope is in Heaven and in Jesus Christ.

A great reading for Lent which I recommend is *Spe Salvi*, it was a letter written by Pope Benedict XVI, a man of exemplary intellect and knowledge. It is my favorite of his written works. It is densely filled with wisdom, philosophy, and Christian Tradition.

Looking at the Cross of Jesus is a sign of great hope. It may seem paradoxical in appearance. Looking at it solely in appearance may seem to be an image of defeat. Beholding the image of the Cross with faith, it is an image of love, hope, and redemption. Let us remember one of the last words of Jesus: *Into your hands O Lord, I commend my spirit.* Jesus, the Son of the Father, placed in His hope and confidence in the Father.

There have been great witnesses of saints and people that we know that have lived Christian hope to its fullest. I am sure you can name many people who through great affliction and suffering still had hope. A great example of hope for me is St. John Paul II and a wonderful priest, Fr. Charles Kohli who is a great mentor to me. Furthermore, there are many hopeful religious and lay faithful who I have known over the years in which I cannot fit their names in this letter.

Permit me to include from *Spe Salvi*: *“As Christians, we should never limit ourselves to asking: how can I save myself? We should also ask: what can I do in order that others may be saved and that for them, too, the star of hope may rise? Then I will have done my utmost for my personal salvation as well.”*

¡Bendito sea el Santo Nombre de María!

¡Ha llegado el Domingo de Laetare! Este domingo siempre cae en el cuarto domingo de Cuaresma. Significa regocijo. Aunque es tiempo de penitencia y conversión, la Cuaresma es tiempo de gran esperanza.

Esperar es anhelar algo que aún no se ha alcanzado. Puede ser para alguien en extrema necesidad o para alguien que lo tiene todo a su favor. En pocas palabras, como cristianos, nuestra esperanza está en el Cielo y en Jesucristo.

Una gran lectura para la Cuaresma que recomiendo es *Spe Salvi*, una carta escrita por el Papa Benedicto XVI, un hombre de intelecto y conocimiento ejemplares. Es mi obra favorita. Está llena de sabiduría, filosofía y tradición cristiana.

Contemplar la Cruz de Jesús es un signo de gran esperanza. Puede parecer paradójica en apariencia. Mirarla solo en apariencia puede parecer una imagen de derrota. Contemplar la imagen de la Cruz con fe es una imagen de amor, esperanza y redención. Recordemos una de las últimas palabras de Jesús: En tus manos, Señor, encomiendo mi espíritu. Jesús, el Hijo del Padre, depositó su esperanza y confianza en el Padre.

Ha habido grandes testigos, santos y personas que conocemos, que han vivido la esperanza cristiana al máximo. Estoy seguro de que pueden nombrar a muchas personas que, a pesar de la gran aflicción y el sufrimiento, aún conservaron la esperanza. Un gran ejemplo de esperanza para mí es San Juan Pablo II y un maravilloso sacerdote, el Padre Charles Kohli, quien es un gran mentor para mí. Además, hay muchos religiosos y fieles laicos llenos de esperanza que he conocido a lo largo de los años, cuyos nombres no puedo incluir en esta carta.

Permítanme incluir de *la Spe Salvi*: «Como cristianos, nunca debemos limitarnos a preguntarnos: ¿cómo puedo salvarme? También debemos preguntarnos: ¿qué puedo hacer para que otros se salven y para que también para ellos brille la estrella de la esperanza? Entonces habré hecho todo lo posible por mi salvación personal».
