Readings for Second Sunday of Lent

1st Reading: Genesis 15:5-12, 17-18 God is manifested in a starry sky, fearful darkness, a smoking pot, and a flaming torch.

2nd Reading: Philippians 3:17-4:1 or 3:20-4:1 Our citizenship is in heaven, where a glorified existence awaits us.

Gospel: Luke 9:28b-36 Jesus holds a summit with Moses and Elijah about his coming exodus.

FOCUS: This season of Lent prepares us for Easter, when we celebrate the Lord's resurrection. In today's Gospel, Peter, John and James get a glimpse of Jesus' glorified body. This is the type of body that Paul tells the Philippians we will one day have, as long as we stand firm in our faith—not only in Christ's resurrection, but also in His cross.

Blessed be the Holy Name of Mary!

It has begun. The Season of Lent, in which we prepare for the suffering, death, and Resurrection of Jesus, has arrived.

What better way to start this season with Jesus' temptation in the desert. Even Jesus himself was tempted by the devil. But He did not fail!

We can often be discouraged in Lent when we fail in our resolutions for Jesus. This can be frustrating and lead us to quit completely. Although failure is a real possibility, it should not lead us to stop altogether.

Perhaps you may consider doing something that is rather simple, than too lofty of a goal.

- Doing a daily examination of conscience
- Praying a daily Rosary
- Attending Mass two or three times a week
- Read the Bible for 10 minutes and allow 5 minutes for silent reflection
- Spending 10 minutes of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament

Yet there is one thing that I would ask everyone to consider doing. Please make a good confession in the beginning of Lent. Then spend the rest of the remaining weeks of Lent in preparation of making a good thorough confession, preferably during Holy Week. There will be ample times available to go to confession during Holy Week. I guarantee it!

This is truly what Jesus is desiring in us: conversion, repentance, and a contrite heart. This is what Lent is all about. Please know of my prayers for you during these 40 days of praying, fasting, and almsgiving.

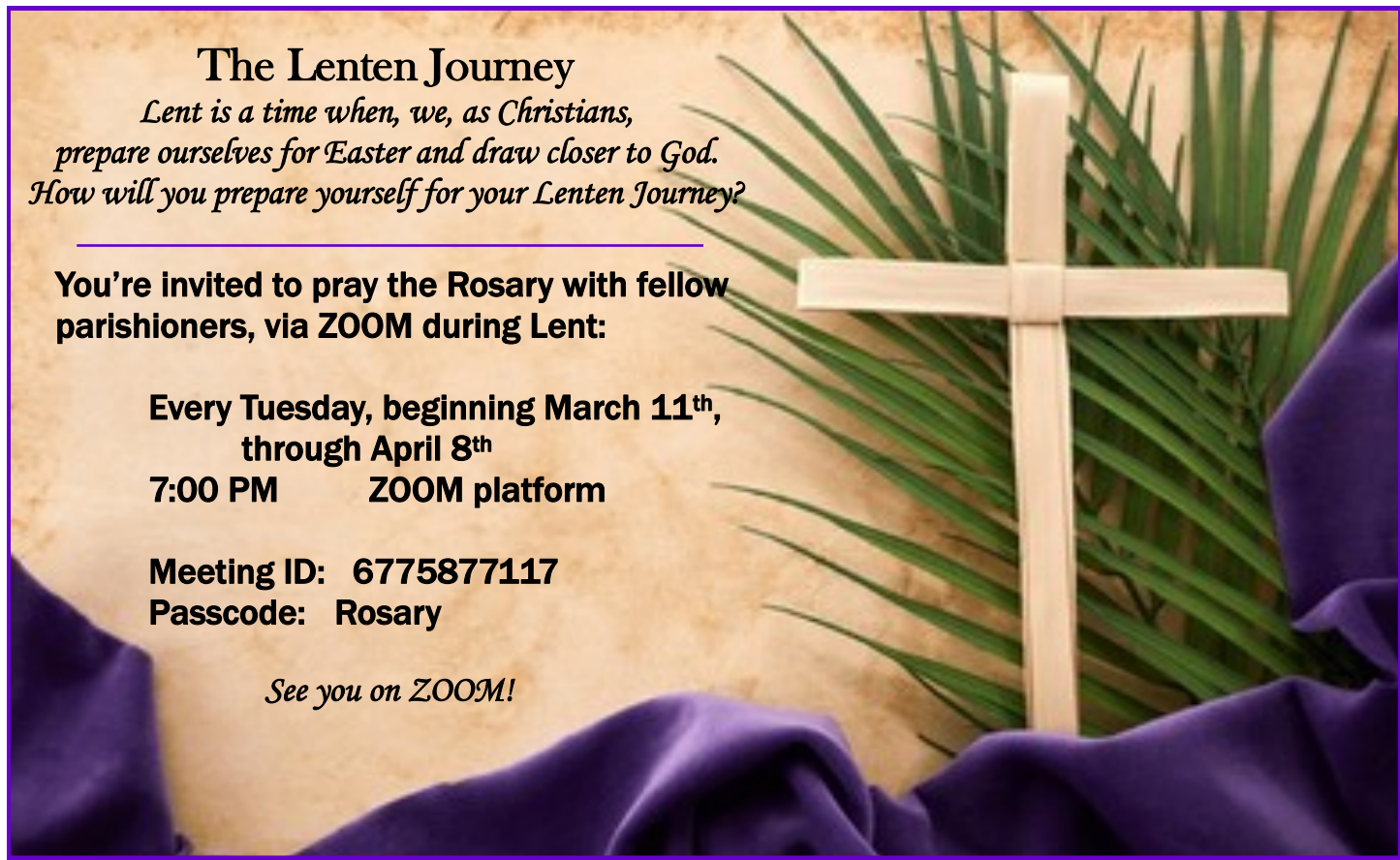

Prayer to St. Joseph

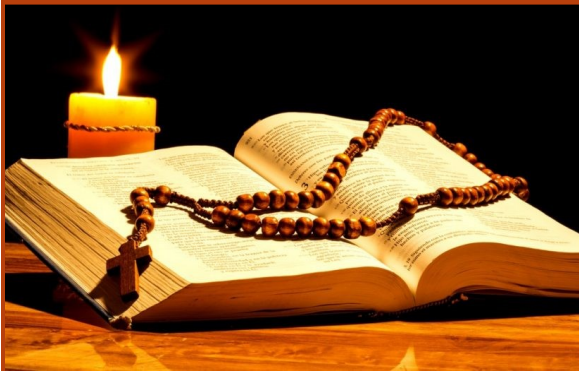

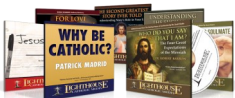

Requirements are as follows:

1. Attend a Virtus: Protecting God's Children class
2. Undergo background screening.
3. Sign the Diocesan Code of Conduct.

Instructions to Complete the Safe Environment Requirements:

1. Log into the Virtus website: www.Virtus.org
2. Begin the registration process by creating a Virtus account. The first screen requests the location: Please select Rockville Centre from the drop-down list.
3. Follow directions on each page.
4. During the registration process you will receive a copy of the Code of Conduct and Pastoral Code of Conduct. Please sign each Code electronically.
5. Select the class you wish to attend.
6. Complete the background screening application provided. Background screening is conducted by Sterling Volunteers.

When you complete the registration process, you will have a Virtus account and an account with Sterling Volunteers. Your Virtus account will contain the date you signed the Codes of Conduct; date you submitted the background screening application and date you will attend Virtus. Please keep your username and the password for both your Virtus account and Sterling account as these are required to access each account.
