Gospel: *Luke 22:14-23:56 or Luke 23:1-49* The Passion of Jesus is acute, and yet he does not forget his compassion for sinners.

FOCUS: **Because Christ humbled Himself, God greatly exalted Him.** Luke's Gospel emphasizes the need for disciples of Christ to follow in His footsteps, as Jesus tells the Apostles that He is among them as the one who serve. The servant who is spoken of in the first reading, Christ does not refuse his calling. He willingly submits to suffering for our sake. Following Christ's example, it is through humble service to one another that we will be exalted.

Blessed be the Holy Name of Mary!

Wow! Easter is approaching fast and so is Holy Week. I have to say one of my favorite days of the entire year is almost here. This does not include high holy days such as Christmas and Easter. Outside of Solemnities and opening day of Major League Baseball, Reconciliation Monday (April 14) is one of my favorite days of the entire year.

This day, which always falls on Monday of Holy Week, is a day that is well advertised and focused on one sacrament, which is Confession. **The Archdiocese of New York, the Diocese of Brooklyn and the Diocese of Rockville Centre have confessions available at their parishes from 2:00 PM - 4:00 PM & 6:00 PM – 9:00PM on this day.** Our parish will follow this schedule but there may be some parishes that have a modified schedule. So please call ahead if you are going to another parish.

The number of penitents that go to confession on this day is very hopeful and edifying. I have kept count of how many people have come to me for confession on this day. On average throughout the years, I would say it is about 95 souls that come to me, alone! Which means that I hear confessions practically nonstop for two hours and then three hours straight.

One of the best ways you can have a fruitful Lent, even if you have slacked on your prayer life, is to make a good confession. Remember if you are nervous about going to confession or are unsure of what to say, just tell any of the priests of Holy Name of Mary that you are a friend of the Blessed Mother. The priest will make it as easy as possible for you.

Please come to Confession on Reconciliation Monday (April 14). It is the Super Bowl Day for Confessions. We try to make it as convenient and fruitful as possible for you. God bless you.

All Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are bound to observe the laws of fast on Good Friday. Fasting means limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Two other light meals, which together do not equal a full meal, may be taken during the day.

The third day of the Triduum is filled with the wonder of the resurrection. The Easter Vigil is the high point of the liturgical year. The Paschal Triduum officially concludes on Easter Sunday, but the wonder of the Easter Season extends for a full 50 days!
