Blessed be the Holy Name of Mary!

I presume as you read this letter, Holy Mother Church has a new pope. But as I am writing this letter, the conclave has begun, and a new pope has not been elected. So, I along with the whole world are patiently waiting and praying.

It is remarkable how entirely different an election of a pope is then from any other election. Although the pope is the head of government of the Vatican City, his function is more centralized as one who has supreme, immediate, and universal authority over the Catholic Church.

Unlike government elections, there is no campaigning. Although leading up to the conclave, cardinals do give speeches to their brother cardinals to express what must be done for the future of the Catholic Church. There is no smearing one's good name. There is no public slander nor detraction. How virtuous and civil that sounds! There are no polls and results of the conclave are kept secret, which probably drives the media and the rest of the world crazy!

Being voted to be the successor of St. Peter is not something someone should eagerly want. Rather, it is a calling that one should accept unworthily. It has been reported in past conclaves that certain popes have explicitly refused to accept being pope after they were elected and then were elected again in the next balloting and finally accepted it.

Instead of winning states or leading in the popular vote the only visible outcome we get is white or black smoke, and the new pope appears from the balcony of St. Peter's. How simple!

Allow me to leave with a prayer from the Roman Missal for the election of a new pope;

*O God, eternal shepherd, who govern your flock with unfailing care,
grant in your boundless fatherly love a pastor for your Church
who will please you by his holiness and to us show watchful care.
Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son,
who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
God, for ever and ever. Amen.*

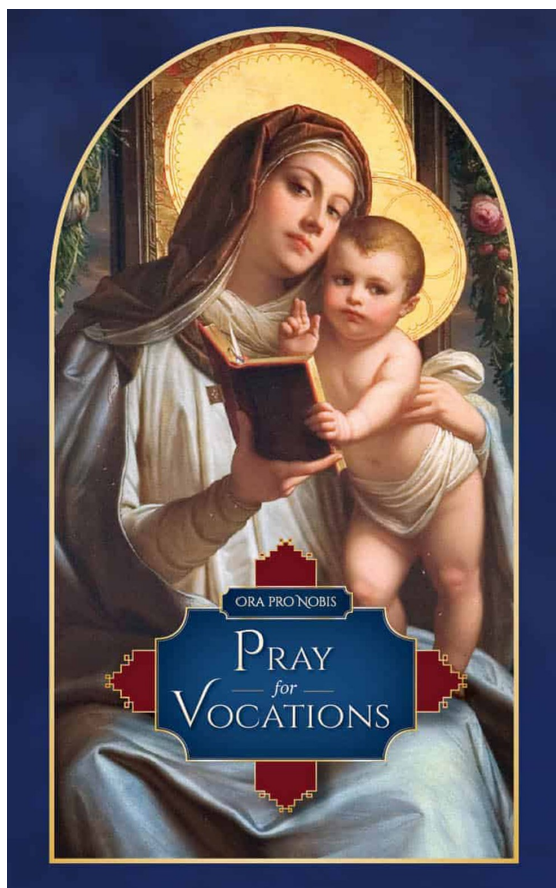

¡Bendito sea el Santo Nombre de María!

Supongo que, mientras leen esta carta, la Santa Madre Iglesia tiene un nuevo papa. Pero mientras escribo, el cónclave ya ha comenzado y aún no se ha elegido un nuevo papa. Por lo tanto, yo, junto con el mundo entero, esperamos y rezamos pacientemente.

Es notable lo completamente diferente que es la elección de un papa de cualquier otra elección. Si bien el papa es el jefe de gobierno de la Ciudad del Vaticano, su función es más centralizada, ya que ostenta la autoridad suprema, inmediata y universal sobre la Iglesia Católica.

A diferencia de las elecciones gubernamentales, no hay campaña electoral. Aunque antes del cónclave, los cardenales pronuncian discursos a sus hermanos cardenales para expresar lo que debe hacerse por el futuro de la Iglesia Católica. No se mancha el buen nombre. Ser elegido sucesor de San Pedro no es algo que se deba anhelar. Es, más bien, un llamado que se debe aceptar indignamente. Se ha informado en cónclaves anteriores que algunos papas se negaron explícitamente a aceptar el papado tras ser elegidos, y que luego fueron reelegidos en la siguiente votación y finalmente lo aceptaron.

En lugar de ganar estados o liderar el voto popular, el único resultado visible que obtenemos es humo blanco o negro, y el nuevo papa aparece desde el balcón de San Pedro. ¡Qué sencillo!

Permítanme despedirme con una oración del Misal Romano para la elección de un nuevo papa:

*Oh Dios, eterno pastor, que gobiernas tu rebaño con inagotable solicitud,
concede, en tu infinito amor paternal, un pastor para tu Iglesia
que te agrade por su santidad y nos muestre un cuidado solícito.
Por nuestro Señor Jesucristo, tu Hijo,
que vive y reina contigo en la unidad del Espíritu Santo,
Dios, por los siglos de los siglos. Amén.*
