Liturgy for Next Sunday—July 6

Readings for 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time

1st Reading: Isaiah 66:10-14c Jerusalem has much to celebrate: abundant prosperity & consolations of God. 2nd Reading: Galatians 6:14-18 Paul boasts only in the cross of Christ through which the world is lost and salvation gained.

Gospel: Luke 10:1-12, 17-20 or 10:1-9 The 72 rejoice because they share in the power of the reign of God. FOCUS: If we share in Christ's suffering, we will share His joy. Paul tells the Galatians that it is no longer circumcision or uncircumcision that sets God's people apart. Instead, at our baptism, we were marked for Christ with the sign of the cross. This indelible seal sets us apart to share in Christ's mission, but also in His suffering. We have hope that we who have died with Christ will also rise with Him to live in the new Jerusalem.
