Blessed be the Holy Name of Mary!

One of the most grateful titles a Catholic can be asked by another is to be a sponsor for a loved one.

A common misunderstanding of a sponsor, aka, godparent is that they are to take care of the child if the parents pass away. That may be a cultural practice, but it is not strictly a religious one. The role of the sponsor is to care for the spiritual well-being of the person being baptized or confirmed. A sponsor helps the baptized person to lead a Christian life in keeping with baptism and to fulfill faithfully the obligations inherent in it. (Code of Canon Law).

A sponsor is a practicing Catholic who has received all the Sacraments of Christian Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist). They must be active in their Catholic faith. They cannot be under any canonical penalty, nor can they be the parents of the child being baptized or confirmed.

A sponsor should not be chosen merely because one is a family member or a close friend. Choosing a sponsor should be done carefully. In fact, once the baptism or confirmation has taken place, the person's sponsor can never be removed from their baptismal record.

Unfortunately, it has happened that family arguments may break out between choosing sponsors or setting a date with the challenge of having everyone present. Having the child baptized sooner is more important than delaying it so that everyone can be present.

Parents are obliged to ensure that their children are baptized within a few weeks after their birth; or as soon as possible after the birth. They are to go to the pastor to request the sacrament for their child and to be prepared properly for it (Code of Canon Law).

Being asked to be a sponsor is a wonderful honor. The person that asks you feels the presence of Jesus Christ within you. You have been asked because, in a way, God wills it. Jesus wills that you lead one of His children to His Heart.

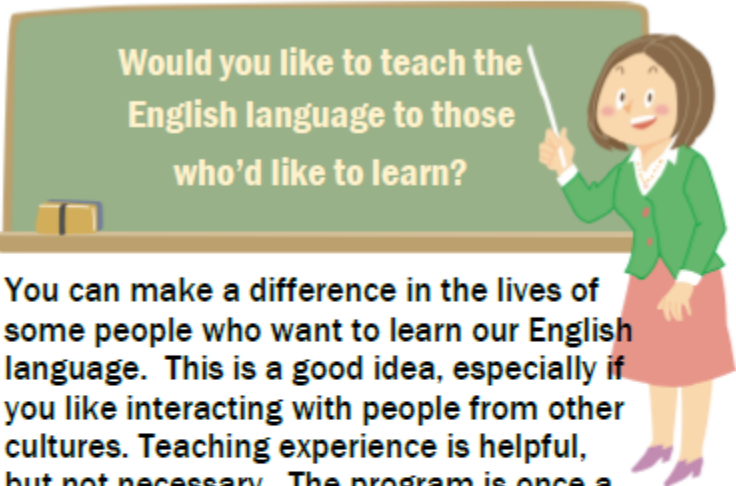

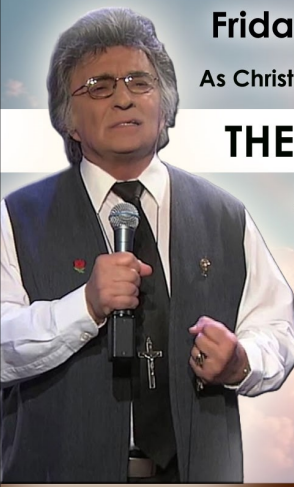

¡Bendito sea el Santo Nombre de María!

Uno de los títulos más gratificantes que se le puede pedir a un católico es ser padrino de un ser querido.

Un malentendido común sobre el padrino es que debe cuidar del niño si sus padres fallecen. Esto puede ser una práctica cultural, pero no estrictamente religiosa. La función del padrino es velar por el bienestar espiritual de la persona que se bautiza o confirma. Un padrino ayuda a la persona bautizada a llevar una vida cristiana conforme al bautismo y a cumplir fielmente con las obligaciones inherentes a él (Código de Derecho Canónico).

Un padrino es un católico practicante que ha recibido todos los sacramentos de la Iniciación Cristiana (Bautismo, Confirmación y Eucaristía). Debe ser activo en su fe católica. No puede estar bajo ninguna sanción canónica, ni ser los padres del niño que se bautiza o confirma.

No se debe elegir a un padrino solo por ser un familiar o un amigo cercano. La elección de un padrino debe hacerse con cuidado. De hecho, una vez realizado el bautismo o la confirmación, el padrino de la persona nunca podrá ser eliminado de su registro bautismal.

Desafortunadamente, han surgido discusiones familiares entre la elección de padrinos o la fijación de una fecha, con el reto de que todos estén presentes. Bautizar al niño cuanto antes es más importante que retrasarlo para que todos puedan estar presentes.

Los padres tienen la obligación de asegurar que sus hijos sean bautizados dentro de las primeras semanas de su nacimiento, o lo antes posible. Deben acudir al párroco para solicitar el sacramento para su hijo y prepararse adecuadamente (Código de Derecho Canónico).

Ser invitado a ser padrino es un gran honor. Quien te lo pide siente la presencia de Jesucristo en ti. Has sido invitado porque, en cierto modo, Dios lo quiere. Jesús quiere que lleves a uno de sus hijos a su Corazón.
