and the prayerful support of the parish community.

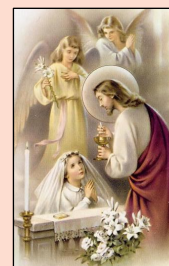
The *Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick* is for

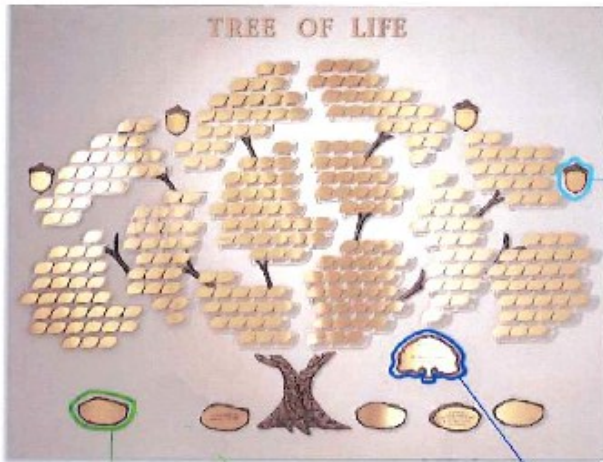
