Blessed be the Holy Name of Mary!

It is a permanent change, a strengthening, and a Divine sending. These are the words that describe Pentecost Sunday. In addition, they describe the Sacrament of Confirmation.

On this day, the apostles were forever changed. They received the Holy Spirit with all its gifts. They were now able to go out to the world and proclaim the Good News. They were not afraid. Threats and even violence did not stop them. They were committed to serve the Lord with truth and charity. There are still disciples today in our own country who are committed to the Lord amid such great resistance. Recent examples are Servant of God, Walter Ciszek and Blessed Stanely Rother who faced great persecution and remained faithful to Jesus.

Let us pray for our fellow adult brothers and sisters who were confirmed today at our parish and throughout the Catholic Church. Even more intensely, let us pray for the youth of our parish who will be confirmed at the end of this month. Sadly, it is very common that many of those who are newly confirmed do not return to the parish and do not receive the sacraments of the Holy Eucharist and Reconciliation until years later.

Pope Leo XIV says, "Persevere in the faith, to return to the parish- there are so many activities, so many opportunities – but above all in the life of the faith, because Jesus Christ wants to walk with you, with each one of you, and with all of you in community, which is so important."

The most often used phrase in the Bible is, "*Be not afraid.*" Jesus Himself says this frequently in the Gospels. The Lord knows we struggle so intensely with fear. As Teresa of Avila says. "All things pass; only God remains."

FOCUS: **God, the Holy Trinity, is perfect Love.**

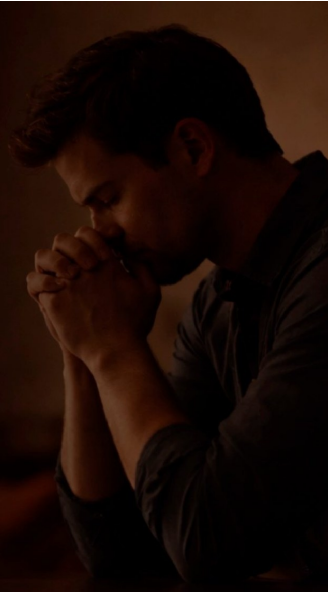

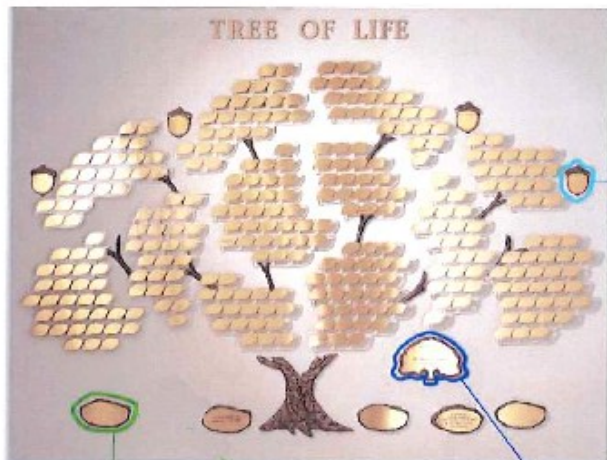

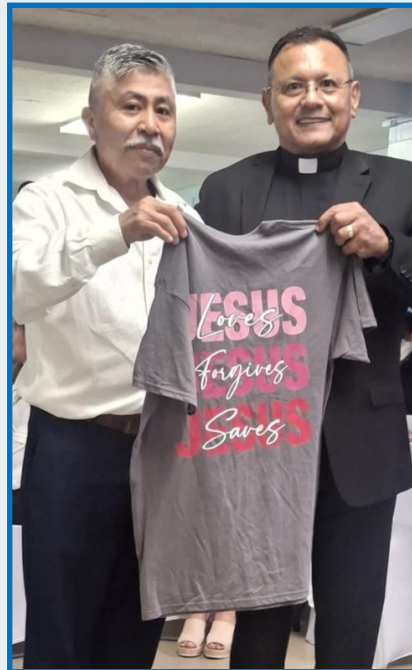

Es un cambio permanente, un fortalecimiento y un envío divino. Estas son las palabras que describen el Domingo de Pentecostés. Además, describen el Sacramento de la Confirmación.

En este día, los apóstoles fueron transformados para siempre. Recibieron el Espíritu Santo con todos sus dones. Ahora eran capaces de salir al mundo y proclamar la Buena Nueva. No tuvieron miedo. Ni las amenazas ni siquiera la violencia lograron detenerlos. Estaban comprometidos a servir al Señor con verdad y caridad.

Hoy en día, todavía hay discípulos en nuestro propio país que permanecen comprometidos con el Señor en medio de una resistencia tan grande. Ejemplos recientes son el Siervo de Dios Walter Ciszek y el Beato Stanley Rother, quienes enfrentaron una gran persecución y se mantuvieron fieles a Jesús.

Oremos por nuestros hermanos y hermanas adultos que hoy han sido confirmados en nuestra parroquia y en toda la Iglesia Católica. Y, con aún mayor intensidad, oremos por los jóvenes de nuestra parroquia que recibirán la Confirmación a finales de este mes. Lamentablemente, es muy común que muchos de los recién confirmados no regresen a la parroquia ni reciban los sacramentos de la Sagrada Eucaristía y la Reconciliación hasta años más tarde.

El Papa León XIV afirma: “Perseveren en la fe; regresen a la parroquia —hay tantas actividades, tantas oportunidades—, pero, sobre todo, perseveren en la vida de fe, porque Jesucristo desea caminar con ustedes, con cada uno de ustedes y con todos ustedes en comunidad, lo cual es sumamente importante”.

La frase que se repite con mayor frecuencia en la Biblia es: “No tengan miedo”. El propio Jesús la pronuncia a menudo en los Evangelios. El Señor sabe que luchamos intensamente contra el miedo. Como dice Teresa de Ávila: “Todo pasa; solo Dios permanece”.
